SEI's Native American programs partner with tribal communities across the country to expand renewable energy and workforce development opportunities, providing community members with the skills and knowledge needed to access well-paying jobs in a rapidly growing sector.

To meet the unique challenges and opportunities on tribal lands, SEI's curriculum is paired with local leadership and knowledge to shape the future of energy production while preserving cultural values and traditions.

Tribal Train the Trainer

SEI's Tribal Train the Trainer program acknowledges the importance of instructors that represent the communities they serve, and has partnered with tribal partners in developing an instructor-training and incubator program for tribal members. Tribal Train the Trainer allows subject-matter experts to become well-versed instructors of SEI's curriculum, and teach SEI courses in their home communities.

Native American Scholarships

SEI scholarships for any tribal member increase access to both our online and in-person training, removing financial barriers to advanced technical training in the solar industry and supporting students in starting new careers in renewable energy.

Curriculum Licensing

SEI offers pro bono curriculum licensing to tribal universities and colleges, supporting nativerun educational institutions in developing and strengthening their technical training programs and solar industry-related programs of study, preparing students for post-college solar careers.
